CAREER SPOTLIGHT

The CHS Counseling Department shares Career information throughout the year. If you have questions or would like additional info, CHS Counselors are here to help.

If you have ever thought about entering the fields of Business or Marketing, here are some jobs that you may want to look into:

Executive Administrative Assistants start out in the \$34,000-40,000 range. This often requires some coursework and training at the community college. Mesa, Gateway, and Phoenix Community Colleges offer training in this field.

Sales Representatives start out in the \$25,000-35,000 range with some training at the community college. Most of the community colleges offer business related training that can prepare you for a job in sales.

Marketing Managers have the median salary of \$127,000. This generally requires a Bachelor's degree in Marketing. All of the State universities offer this degree.
